According to legal conditions, including the Chain Liability Act (Wet Keten Aansprakelijkheid or WKA) and the Foreign Nationals Employment Act (Wet Arbeid Vreemdelingen or WAV), the Client is obligated to collect evidence and data from all workers working on their project. The Client uses digital registration systems such as "Bouwpas" or "Werktveilig" for this purpose, requesting only the necessary data as required by legislation.

The Contractor must ensure that the workers they deploy on the project are pre-registered in the applicable registration system for the project. The Contractor will receive a separate invitation from the project via email for this purpose.

To enter the project or work area, workers of the Contractor must, in addition to mandatory evidence, possess a valid VCA certificate, GPI (General site safety instruction), and valid identification (excluding a driver's license). The responsibility and associated costs for obtaining the GPI lies entirely with the Contractor. More information about the GPI can be found at https://www.duravermeer.nl/opdrachtnemers.

Foreign workers must also possess the necessary documents as specified in the Foreign Nationals Employment Act (Wav). If there is no exemption for European Union labor traffic, the Contractor must provide the Client with a copy of the valid identity document and the valid residence document.

On the first working day, employees must be able to identify themselves upon arrival at the construction site with a valid, original identification document, excluding a driver's license. If the employees cannot provide the mentioned documents on the first working day, they will not be allowed access to the construction site. The Contractor guarantees compliance with all applicable laws and regulations in the Netherlands for workers deployed for the work.
